Bylaw No. 05-2014

A Bylaw to Amend Bylaw P23/77 known as the Zoning Bylaw

The Council of the Town of Rouleau in the province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

Bylaw P23/77 is amended by adding:

- * A Building Permit is required:
 - before the start of any construction
 - when changing the structure of an existing building.
 - building a new home or garage
 - when adding a deck over 100 (one hundred) square feet
 - building a shed over 100 (one hundred) square feet
 - building fences over 6 (six) feet high.
- * Construction cannot begin until approval is received.

Fines

* If construction has commenced prior to obtaining a Building Permit, a written warning will be issued by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer and/or Building Inspector to apply for and obtain a permit within 72 (seventy-two) hours. If no permit is obtained a fine in the amount of \$100.00 (one hundred dollars) per day will be levied against the property owner

Section 7.2 (2) (a)(b) be amended to:

minimum floor area - 1000 (one thousand) square feet

Coming Into Force

This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of third and final reading by the Council of the Town of Rouleau.
